



Are you a refugee or asylum seeker living in Bristol or London? Do you identify as LGBTQI+, queer or gender non-conforming? Have you been receiving support from local organisations and communities because of your sexuality, gender identity and refugee status? Have you been providing support to other refugees and asylum seekers fleeing from gender and sexuality-based persecution?

If you are an LGBTQI+ refugee who is 18+ years old, you are invited to participate in a research study. I am interested in finding out about the support that exists for LGBTI+ refugees in England. This includes your experiences of accessing support, living in cities like Bristol and London, the challenges you have faced, and what you think can be done to improve the situation for LGBTQI+ refugees.

Taking part will involve participating in a 30-45-minute phone interview where you will be invited to talk about your experiences. Anything you say to me will be anonymised and you will not be named in any write up. If it is not possible to speak by phone, but you are still interested in taking part, then an in-person interview can be arranged in a safe Covid-secure setting or at a later date. You will be given a £10 voucher for your time.
